At the site, a casino, in the river valley along the Nile in Luxor, southern Egypt. The attack Unidentified gunmen entered the hotel, which had 800 rooms, and opened fire. The Egyptian minister of tourism, Omar Marwan, said that the attackers had "come to loot." The attack was carried out by about nine attackers, who entered the building at 08:30 and killed everyone in the lobby, including four security guards. The attackers also fired in the direction of the entrance to the cafeteria and the ballroom. Then they went on to the main building, where they killed 38 people and wounded 58. The dead included 47 adults, five children and one infant, and an unknown number of others injured. . . . There was a stampede, and people were trampled and suffocated on the stairs and by the elevators. . . . The attackers shot people in the hallways and on the stairways. . . . Around 30 hours later, after an exchange of gunfire at the airport, some of the bodies were removed from the scene by soldiers. . . . by the

time the investigators from the forensic and ballistics team and the prosecutor of the airport scene were at the scene of the massacre. Victims In a list published by the Egyptian government, most of the dead had been tourists, or people from a nearby village called Katameya. Among them were a priest, two French journalists, and an Italian woman. Five of the dead had been shot in the head at close range. There was one heart attack victim, and one incident of an elderly woman being shot in the back. The head of the emergency room, who was shot in the face and killed, worked for the private hospital of El Azhar University in Cairo, where a number of those wounded in the attack were treated. Victims included: Foreign nationals Egyptian nationals Aftermath The attack was carried out by four men wearing military-style uniforms. The attack followed on from a string of similar attacks in Egypt, which had been attributed to Islamic fundamentalists. The New York Times wrote that the attack had "followed earlier bombings, assassinations and shooting attacks against the government and foreigners by radical Islamists who in the last two years have appeared increasingly willing to challenge the authority of a secular government that has cracked down on many religious-based groups." . . .
